

What is the Registration Fee for Players to participate in the 2022 A/E NCAA March Madness® Bracket Challenge?

There is no fee to participate as a “Player” in the 2022 A/E NCAA March Madness® Bracket Challenge so long as a player meets the eligibility requirements stated in or implied by the official rules, namely:

- a. Participants (also referred to as “Players”) must be 18 years old and have a valid email address and working telephone number.
- b. Participants must register profiles both at [A/E Ask the Experts](#) powered by TradeWing and on CBSSports.com.
- c. Participants are not required to be A/E Members to play.
- d. A/E Board Members and Staff are eligible to participate and claim prizes.

What is the A/E Bracket Challenge 2022 Cancellation Policy?

Player Registration Cancellations:

Players may stop participating in the 2022 A/E NCAA March Madness® Bracket Challenge at any time.

Sponsorship Cancellations:

Cancellations must be submitted to A/E in writing. The date of receipt of supporter’s written notice of cancellation will be the official cancellation date. Exhibitors who cancel on or before 26 February 2022 will receive a full refund less a \$225 processing fee. Sponsors who cancel after February 26th but before 6 March 2022 will receive a refund equal to 85% of the total sponsorship fee. **Exhibitor and sponsorship fees are nonrefundable after 6 March 2022.**

Cancellation requests must be submitted in writing to meetings@afe.org. When does registration close for A/E Bracket Challenge 2022?

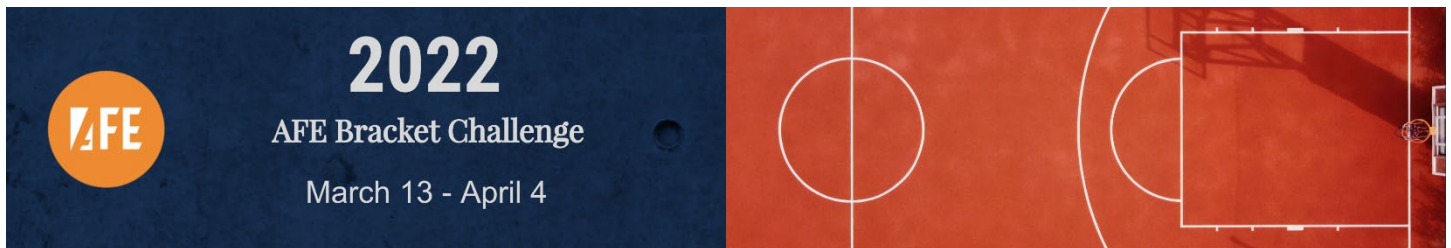
Registration for the 2022 A/E NCAA March Madness® Bracket Challenge closes at 11:59 PM EST on Thursday, March 17th.
